# OUR PROGRAMS




- ▶ **University Transfer (UT)**  
This allows students to transfer to a university, with both one-year and two-year pathways, ultimately leading to a degree at a partnering institution.
- ▶ **Associate of Arts (AA)**  
Two-year program designed to provide students with a broad foundation in liberal arts, including courses in humanities, social sciences, and science.
- ▶ **High School Completion**  
It includes the Dogwood Diploma and the Adult Graduation Program for students to complete the high school requirements.
- ▶ **English Studies Program**  
Focuses on improving English proficiency, offering a Certificate Program and University Preparation courses for those looking to enhance their language skills.






At Coquitlam College, we're pleased to offer the resources, services, and support to help you succeed during your time with us.

# HOMESTAY

## ▶ Safe & Comfortable

Students receive a private furnished bedroom, meals, and access to shared facilities like bathrooms, laundry, and Wi-Fi in a secure home environment.

## ▶ Cultural Immersion and Language Development

Living with an English-speaking Canadian family helps students practice English daily and experience Canadian customs firsthand.

## ▶ Personalized Support and Integration

The Homestay Coordinator assists with family placement and ongoing support, and there's a one-month trial period to ensure a good match.

## ▶ Convenient Location and Accessibility

Homestays are typically within 30–40 minutes of the college and near public transit, making commuting easy and reliable.

## ▶ Transparent and Reasonable Costs

Monthly fees are affordable, and optional services like airport pickup and custodianship are available for an additional fee.




